Introduction

The City and Guilds 2382-18 '18th Edition' electrical qualification is available as either a 3 day (for experienced electricians) or a 5 day (for inexperienced/non-electricians who don't hold a previous qualification) course.

For **inexperienced or non-electricians** the 18th Edition can be taken as a 5 day course.

There are no formal entry requirements but **a basic knowledge of electrical science is essential.** (Anyone with no knowledge at all should consider taking our Foundation Electrics course first.)

Objective

To achieve the 18th Edition, City and Guilds 2382-18 qualification.

Methodology

Teaching will be by means of presentations and discussion sessions combined with worked examples.

At the end of the course candidates will be required to complete one multiple choice, online test (120 minutes).

This is an open book assessment and candidates will be allowed to take in the following permitted reference material:
